Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

As of 2024

O. What are my voting rights in the condominium?

The members of the Association shall be entitled to cast one vote for each condominium unit owned by them.

Q. What restrictions exist on my right to use my unit?

No business activity. Pets are limited to 2 per unit, written approval required for excess of 2 pets per unit and must weigh less than 25 pounds each.

Q. What restrictions exist on the leasing of my unit?

No owner may lease their unit until after 24 months of ownership. The lease shall be minimum of 1 year terms. All rentals must be approved by the Board. Tenants may have pets if owner lease accepts.

Q. How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my unit type and when are they due?

Monthly dues. See the current budget.

Q. Do I have to be a member in any other association?

- Q. Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? No.
- Q. Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000?
