Article 4 Property RightsSection 4.1 Title to Common Area

- (b) The wetland preservation /mitigation areas, upland buffer zones, and/or upland preservation areas are hereby dedicated as conservation and common areas. The conservation/common areas shall be the perpetual responsibility of the Bay Tree Homeowners Assoc. Inc., and may in no way be altered from their natural state with the exception of restoration activities. Activities prohibited within the conservation area include but are not limited to: construction unapproved construction, or placing soil or other substances such as trash; removal or destruction of trees, shrubs, or vegetation —with the exception of exotics/nuisance material; diking or fencing; and any other activities detrimental to drainage, flood control, water conservation, erosion control, or fish and wildlife habitat conservation or preservation.
- (c) Any amendment to this Declaration, which would affect the surface water management system, including the water management portions of the common areas, must have the prior approval of the South Florida Water Management District.
