Things to Know

Your zone may not come on if there has been too much rain. Please wait a couple of zone cycles before you assume there is a problem with your irrigation

* means that the zone is on a doubler. A doubler will connect 2 zones so that you see either one or the other zone running. If there is an interruption in electricity due to a power outage or human intervention, the original zone's time will switch with the other zone and stay that way until another interruption. This is important to know because if your irrigation does not come on as expected, it might be because the signal was interrupted and your irrigation might come on at a different time. The 2 zones are indicated by *zone1-zone2 and then *zone2-zone1.

If there is a drought and the City of Port St Lucie enforces a 2-day per week irrigation schedule, the Monday and Tuesday schedules will be temporarily eliminated.
