## NPT FCC TRASH, RECYCLE, LANDSCAPING & BULKY WASTE **DO'S & DON'T'S**

## EVERY THURSDAY IS OUR PICK-UP DAY THE 4<sup>TH</sup> THURSDAY IS OUR BULKY WASTE PICK-UP DAY PLEASE DO: PLEASE DO NOT:

- Put your cans and debris out after 6
   PM on Wednesday night-ONCE A
   WEEK
- 2. Put out your Bulky Waste only the day before the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of the month-**LIMIT: 2 Cubic Yards/mo**
- 3. Arrange for your landscaper to remove large debris
- 4. EVERYTHING must fit in the cans
- 5. Make sure the lids close tightly
- 6. Put out with the pick-up bar facing the street
- 7. Place your cans a few feet apart
- 8. Pick up anything that falls out of your can
- 9. Use ONLY the **FCC can for trash** and your **GREEN CAN for recycle**
- 10. Order an extra can if needed-1PSL
- 11.Put out your yard waste in an old can or a pile is acceptable-4 Cubic Yards a week allowed
- 12.Bring your cans in by 6 PM the day after pick-ups
- 13.Call 1<sup>st</sup> for a special pick-up before putting it out. Yard and Bulky Waste-772-871-1775 or 1PSL. PSL/FCC charges will apply.
- 14.Use the PSL drop-off center on Cameo & Crosstown if necessary
- 15. **Follow the guidelines** and be respectful of your neighbors

- A. Put out your cans, large yard waste or Bulky waste more than 1 day before pick-up day or your special pick-up
- B. Put your cans and yard waste out before 6 PM the day before pick-up
- C. Put your cans out the day before July4, Thanksgiving and Christmas
- D. Put anything loose or bags outside next to the cans except yard waste and on Bulky Day-**These items** will not get picked up
- E. Put anything out when we have a named storm headed our way
- F. Take offense if you get a warning or violation email or letter. This is a learning curve for all of us. We must all play by the rules.
