RE: "Lake Use Agreement for Sawgrass Lakes"

In response to your memorandum dated October 19, 2007, regarding the lake use agreement I have the following comments.

- The City needs to have assurance from the Master Homeowner's Association
 that they will strictly adhere to any and all irrigation and watering restrictions
 enforced by the South Florida Weber Management District.
- The dry conditions, coupled with the drawing of stormwater for irrigating the subdivisions within the A-4 drainage basin this year, exposed the shoreline in excess of (5) five feet. As a result, it excited the growth of unwanted aquatic vegetation such as Hydrilla and Torpedo Grass. When herbicides are applied to a targeted species such as Hydrilla, the water being drawn for irrigation purposes can negatively impact the turf and landscape on improved properties.
- We did a littoral test plot at the entrance to Panther Trace with the intention of promoting native vegetation along the shoreline. It is imperative that the Homeowner's Association continues promoting shoreline vegetation to neutralize the adverse effects of excessive nutrient levels coming from the improved properties. If this methodology is not embraced, it will negatively impact shoreline stability and recreational use.

Attached herein please find a Second Addendum to the Agreement between the City of Port St. Lucie and the Sawgrass Lakes Master Association, Inc. This Agreement would allow property owners surrounding the various lakes to utilize the lakes for impation purposes. As such, it would also by implication allow the crossing of the riparian easement that surrounds the lake. The city has received complaints from other members in the Sawgrass Lakes development of this encroachment, if you will, by individuals for irrigation purposes.

If the City Council approves said proposed addendum, then utilization of the lake for irrigation proposes would be permitted as well as the crossing of the riparian easement by irrigation pipes, the would be a necessity to allow for said irrigation. If the City Council does not approve said Agreement, the city will then begin taking action against the individual property owners who have trespassed and advise them that they must remove their irrigation lines from the riparian easement.

It should be noted by the City Council, the staff has met with representatives of South Florida Water Management District, who have indicated that they have no objection to utilizing the lake for irrigation purposes by individual property owners as the overall withdrawal from the lake is diminutive in nature. It should also be noted by the City Council, this lake is a storm water retention area which the depth of the lake is govern by a fixed weir. There is the potential in a drought situation that the withdrawal from the lake may drive the level of the lake downward below the fixed weir amount. To what extent that may occur is unknown and is dependent upon both the amount of withdrawals and the length and intensity of any drought that may occur.

WHEREAS, the parties wish to modify the Agreement as set forth below.

- All references to Sawgrass Lakes, Inc. are hereby modified to be Sawgrass Lakes Master Association, Inc. ("Association").
 - 2) Paragraph 2 of the Agreement shall be modified to read as follows:
 - 2. Association and its successors and assigns are hereby granted a non-exclusive license and right to use the premises described as S.W.F.S.L. Pond A4 in Planning Area 731 and as more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein. The non-exclusive license is strictly for the limited purposes of fishing and the use of non-motorized water craft and water craft powered by electric motors up to a fifty-pound thrust. The parties agree that all water craft must be removed from the lake when not in use. Additionally, Association agrees that it will not construct or otherwise authorize the construction of any docks or other permanent improvements within the lake.

The parties acknowledge that the enlargement of the S.W.F.S.L. Pond A4 in Planning Area 731 as outlined on the "Conceptual Development Plan Map" attached hereto as

Exhibit "B", has occurred. The license granted hereunder shall extend to those enlarged premises.

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SECOND ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT

This Second Addendum to Agreement made and entered into this 13 day of November 2007, by and between The City of Port St. Lucie, a municipal corporation, duly organized under the laws of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "City" and Sawgrass Lakes Master Association, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "Association".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City and Sawgrass Lakes, Inc. entered into an Agreement dated December 23, 1996, providing for a license from the City to Sawgrass Lakes, Inc. for limited passive activities of the water body known as S.W.F.S.L. Pond A4 in Planning Area 731, owned by the City.

WHEREAS, Sawgrass Lakes, Inc., exagened its rights in the Agreement to the Association; and

WHEREAS, the parties executed an Addendum to the Agreement dated March 29, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to modify the Agreement as set forth below.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, it is agreed that the Agreement is modified as follows:

- Paragraph 2 of the Agreement shall be modified to read as follows:
 - Association and its successors and assigns are hereby granted a non-exclusive license and right to use the premises described as S.W.F.S.L. Pond A4 in Planning Area 731 and as more particularly described in Exhibits "A" and "B" attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein. The non-exclusive license is strictly for the limited purposes, of fishing; the use of non-motorized water craft and water craft powered by electric motors up to a fifty-pound thrust: and the withdrawal of water from the lake for imigation. The parties agree that all water craft must be removed from the lake when not in use. Additionally, Association agrees that it will not construct or otherwise authorize the construction of any docks or other permanent improvements within the lake. The Association agrees that any withdrawal of water from the lake for imigation purposes shall not: (1) change the profile of the lake; (2) disturb vegetation within the lake; nor (3) increase the turbidity of the lake.

The parties acknowledge that the enlargement of the S.W.F.S.L. Pond A4 in Planning Area 731 as outlined on the "Conceptual Development Plan Map" attached hereto as Exhibit "B", has occurred. The license granted hereunder shall extend to those enlarged premises.

Except as herein modified, all the terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect.
