Thursday is our regular trash, recycle and yard waste pickup days.

The 4th Thursday of every month is our Bulk Garbage pickup day.

If you have items that will not fit in your garbage can and FCC will not pick up on a regular trash day, the BULK DAY is the day to put it out. After 6 PM the night before for ALL items and pick-ups. No other day or time is acceptable.

You can also call for a special pickup anytime. **However, there will be a fee for special pickups**. To schedule a special pickup for bulk waste or yard waste, use the 1PSL app at: 1PSL Port St. Lucie or call 772-871-1775. You should also use this contact information if you have any issues with the FCC services.

In any event, cans <u>and</u> yard waste should not be put out before 6 PM Wednesday nights. Cans should be 3 feet apart to give the truck lift enough room to pick up your can. The only exception is when you schedule a special pickup, they tell you to put it out and they will get to it when they can. If it is out for more than a few days, please call again and request your pick up again. We do not want trash or yard waste out at the curbs every day of the week or all week/month long.

Trash and recycle cans should be stored inside your garage. If that is not possible, please store them behind your house. All garbage must be in the cans and the lids must be closed at all times, even in the backyard, to avoid rodent infestation, for you and your neighbors.

Gearing up for spring cleaning and keeping clutter out of trash

With spring just weeks away, residents might be planning a major home cleaning or purging project. Before starting, the City of Port St. Lucie encourages residents to think sustainably and make a thoughtful disposal plan.

When clearing out unwanted items, picking up yard waste and filling garbage bags, here are some tips to properly disposing of waste:



Inside the home

Cardboard boxes, bottles, cans and paper are all recyclable, while other common household items like old clothes, cleaning supplies, paint and electronics can be given a second life. When considering what to donate or throw away, remember: if it has no value to you or anyone else, then tossing it in the trash is your best bet.

Toss out items like furniture that's in bad shape or beyond repair, broken appliances and large plastic toys. When disposing of these bulk items, don't just leave your furniture on the side of the road in the hopes that someone will pick it up. There are four disposal options:

- Neatly pile bulk curbside on your scheduled pickup day. The limit is 2 cubic yards per month, which is equivalent to a standard-size refrigerator.
- To learn your bulk pickup day, visit www.CityofPSL.com/SolidWaste.



 Schedule a pickup. To get a quote for a scheduled bulk waste pickup, call 1PSL at 772-871-1775 and press 5.



Haul the bulk waste. Residents can voluntarily drop off yard and bulk waste seven days a week, from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. (or dusk), at the City drop-off center at the corner of Cameo Boulevard and Crosstown Parkway.



 Hire a contractor. Residents can use a hauler of their choice and schedule a pickup at their convenience. When negotiating the contract, ensure your debris won't be curbside too long to avoid a violation.





Garage/Shed

When clearing out the nooks and crannies of a garage or shed, you may find hazardous materials like automotive fuel, rechargeable batteries, oil-based paints and pool chemicals. These types of materials are dangerous and not only contaminate ground water but also could start fires and cause an explosion.

Drop them off year-round at the Solid Waste Baling & Recycling Facility, 6120 Glades Cut-Off Road in Fort Pierce. Call 772-462-1768 for hours and for information about what will be accepted. The City also hosts a free **Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day** twice a year. For more information, call 772-871-5100.



Outside the home

A day of cutting grass, pruning shrubs and pulling weeds can leave quite a pile. Try one these four disposal methods:

 Neatly pile vegetation curbside on your scheduled pickup day. There is a yard waste limit of up to 4 cubic yards collected weekly, which is about the size of two standard-size refrigerators.



When disposing of yard waste, cut tree limbs and branches to a manageable size, not exceeding 4 feet (excluding palm fronds), 6 inches in diameter and 50 pounds per piece. Place loose debris (leaves, pine needles, grass clippings, etc.) in a can or bag yard waste by using paper bags instead of plastic. Paper bags can be mulched along with debris, plastic cannot. Make sure the bag is less than 50 pounds when filled.

 Schedule a pickup. To get a quote for a scheduled bulk waste pickup, call 1PSL at 772-871-1775 and press 5.



Haul the yard waste. Residents can voluntarily drop off yard and bulk waste seven days a week, from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. (or dusk), at the City Drop-off Center at the corner of Cameo Boulevard and Crosstown Parkway.



 Hire a contractor. Residents can use a hauler of their choice and schedule a pickup at their convenience. When negotiating the contract, ensure the vendor hauls away the debris or adheres to the 4 cubic yard curbside limit.



Donating your unwanted items is a very noble thing to do. It might not be valuable anymore to you but it might be exactly what someone else is looking for.



Here are some tips to avoid an interruption in solid waste collection:

Place your debris and carts out the night before (after 6 PM) or by 7 a.m. the
day of service, making sure to remove carts from the curb the night of
service.

- Make sure all debris piles and carts are 3 feet away from each other and other obstructions.
- Make sure to stay within the limits: 4 cubic yards of vegetation weekly and 2 cubic yards of bulk monthly.
- Make sure there are no garbage bags outside of your cart or on top of it.
- Make sure all recyclables are loose, clean, dry and inside the recycle cart for service.

Following these tips will ensure your garbage, recycles and yard waste will be picked-up and North Panther Trace will stay clean. For everyone to enjoy and be proud of.

Free Magnet Still Available

Come to City Hall's front desk to have a staff member look up their bulk waste pickup day and mark it on the writable magnet. The magnet can be picked up at City Hall, 121 SW Port St. Lucie Blvd., Bldg. A Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. (excluding holidays).

TIP! Do you miss shows sometimes and forget to record them? Maybe you thought you were taping your show but it ended up being a sporting event or weather reports.

You can download individual station apps to your TV, sign in with your Bluestream info and watch most any show you want, anytime you want. Most of these apps are free to download and use. Some do have a fee and you will be prompted to subscribe if so. This is not mandatory.

Service not acting properly? Unplug the power to your box, wait 45 seconds, plug it back in. This should reboot the system and your service should work properly. Each TV works independently, so you may have to do each one. If this doesn't work, call for service. Bluestream may have to replace your box(es).

*** Make sure they check your TiVo boxes, your HDMI connection on your TV and the Bluestream Fiber connection on the outside of the house. We have had issues with the outside connection not secured properly.

NEED BLUESTREAM SERVICE? Call 772-242-7017 to Schedule your service call. Be sure to ask for a Bluestream tech, not a sub-contractor. If you are on hold for more than a minute or 2, it probably means Bluestream knows there is an issue and they are working on the solution. **You can also contact** Bluestream using this link: https://www.bluestreamfiber.com/community/sawgrass-lakes/

Important Infrastructure Projects Currently Ongoing

Port St. Lucie Boulevard South, Gatlin to Darwin (Segment 3):

- Construction began Jan. 27, 2022
- Anticipated completion: Winter 2023

Port St. Lucie Boulevard South - Darwin to Alcantarra (Segment 2.1):

- Construction on this 0.713-mile widening project began Thursday, Jan. 27, 2022.
- Anticipated Completion: Winter 2023

Gatlin Boulevard/I-95 Interchange Improvements:

- FL Dept. of Transportation managed project
 Project includes the design and construction of one additional left turn lane on the northbound and southbound I-95 off-ramps to Gatlin Boulevard.
- Anticipated completion: Winter 2023

Important Infrastructure Projects on the Horizon

Tulip Boulevard / College Park Road Intersection Improvements:

The project will remove the existing roundabout and extend the median, add an additional lane at the Gatlin Boulevard intersection and extend the lane east of College Park.

• Design is underway. Construction is anticipated to start in Fall 2023.


