

Rules for Pool Use During Covid-19 Pandemic

The Board of Directors is concerned with the safety of all residents and ask that everyone abide by these interim rules during the ongoing pandemic. If adherence to these protocols are not met by all, the Association reserves the right under the State of Emergency of Florida to impose additional restrictions, and/or to re-enact closure of the pool.

- 1.) **Use of pool:** Use of pool is currently restricted to residents only. (No guests, including visiting relatives).
- 2.) **Face masks:** To be worn at all times in pool deck area. Masks may be removed while in the pool. This is in accordance with CDC guidelines.
- 3.) **Social Distancing:** Maintain six (6) feet distance between individuals at all times, in and out of the water. (Applies to persons not of immediate household). In accordance with social distancing mandate of Martin County and CDC guidelines.
- 4.) **No buoyant devices:** No buoyant devices of any type or toys are allowed in the pool at this time.
- 5.) **Sanitizing:** Bring own sanitizing spray and/or wipes to sanitize the bathroom before and after your usage.
- 6.) **Maximum number of people in pool:** The maximum number of people in the pool and/or deck area at any given time will be ten (10). If you have been in the pool for an hour, please be courteous to your neighbors and allow them to enjoy the pool.
- 7.) **Persons with symptoms of Covid-19:** Persons with symptoms of Covid-19; persons who have been tested as positive for the virus, or those who have been exposed to the virus within the last fourteen (14) days are not to use the pool or deck area.

All pool deck furniture has been removed in the interest of safety. Residents may bring their own chairs if desired.
